How to use this Resource Guide...

The information in this Re-Entry Resource Guide may help you locate services you need. You will find agencies offering assistance for housing, food and clothing as well as job search assistance. Tips on using the guide follow.

1. Locate agencies closest to your current residence.
2. Make a list of your needs and seek help for the one that is most urgent. For example, if you have a place to live, your most urgent need may be to look for a job. Locate employment assistance agencies.
3. Missouri has a network of One-Stop Centers called Missouri

Career Centers that offer many services at one site. For example, you may look for a job, study for the GED, and seek family financial assistance at the same location.

- 4. The United Way organization may offer supports services that will help you.
- 5. Churches and religious organizations may also provide assistance in your community.

Once you have made contact with a One-Stop Center or a social service agency you may find that these groups can help you locate other resources. Keeping notes about the contacts you make will be helpful. Use the suggestions below to save time and frustration. Take time to say thanks to those who assist you. They will be happy to know when you are employed or have made progress toward your goals.

How to ask a question and get results...

An effective call:

- *Have a paper and pencil ready when you make a call. Be ready to give a brief but complete account of what you need– eliminate unrelated information.
- *Be ready to provide your full name and contact information such as how or where you can be reached or get messages.
- *If your inquiry involves an agency that uses an identifying case or file number (example: Social Security), have that number ready.
- *Be sure to record the name and title of persons you talk to and confirm their phone numbers in your notes.
- *Keep your notes together on all of your contacts to each agency so that you can supply information when you make follow-up calls.

Your School
After you have decided on a career and where you want to go to school, you will need to obtain an admissions application from that school. Each school has different admissions criteria. It is important to be upfront from the beginning.

Application Process
Your school will provide free admissions counseling. The counselor will help you complete the admissions application along with obtaining other necessary documents (G.E.D., transcripts, and vaccination records).

You Have Been Accepted
You will likely receive your acceptance notification letter

through the mail. If accepted, you will be responsible to make two important appointments. You must first meet with the financial aid department to determine how much money is available. Next you will meet with an academic advisor to determine what classes to take and set up a schedule.

Offenders Guide to College
Or Technical School

Myth – I cannot afford to go to school.

Fact – Although ex-offenders are not entitled to any “special” funding, you are eligible for the same financial aid as everyone else.

Drug offenders may have to complete a substance abuse program. You may have already done this in DOC.

Financial aid usually covers the cost of tuition, books, and some living expenses however most students work part-time.

Myth – Because I have been to prison, I am eligible for VocRehab.

Fact – If you have a disability you may qualify, being in prison itself is NOT a disability.

Myth – My P.O. will want me to work full-time.

Fact – Full-time enrollment in school counts as a full-time job

Financial aid is a combination of grants and loans for students who cannot afford to go to school. Your income over the past year will determine how much aid you get. This means most offenders will qualify for the maximum amount.

Grants vs. Loans

Grant money is free and does not need to be paid back. Loans are awarded under the condition they are paid back **AFTER** you graduate or leave school. If you currently owe on student loans you may have to make six months of payments before you can re-apply.

How do I get Financial Aid?

A Free Application for Student Aid (FAFSA) is the standard application used at all accredited schools.

The first step is to complete a FAFSA application. Applications and free assistance are available through the financial aid department of your school or from FAFSA. (1-800-433-3243)

Oxford Houses are set up so an individual may have all the comforts of a nice big home, and in many cases their own room and the added feeling of a brother or sisterhood right in the same place with you.

Rent for this type of housing is fairly inexpensive, it usually ranges from about \$225 per month for a double room to about \$300 for a single and all prices in between, still keep in mind that it's a place to get on your feet so initial money is not an issue, but employment or other regular income like disability is a must.

Included in this price for your rent is always water, electricity, gas, and cable television, etc., the house does supply condiments and your laundry needs like detergent and bleach and the machines, you must supply your own food and toiletries.

However it is a great place for those who want a good shot at getting their life back on track.
